What is Quizlet

- Free online tool to organise study sets, for mobiles, laptop and tablet
- Study a topic by searching already made sets or creating your own
- Organise live games to test students' knowledges and abilities to teamwork

What Quizlet offers

- make flashcards,
- practice spelling,
- play learning games,
- test knowledge,
- collaborate with other students
- create folders of sets and invite students to join
- create virtual classrooms and invite students to join

Starting with Quizlet

When you start with Quizlet as a teacher, first of all you have to **create a set of words** that you want your students to study.

You can:

- Choose an existing set and change it
- Build your own set from zero

How to *build/change* a set

When you create a set, you can choose to associate:

- A Word and its translation

Example: Star – Stella

- A Word and its definition

Example: Star – a fixed luminous point in the night sky which is a large, remote incandescent body like the sun

- A Word and a picture

Example: Star –



Learning

- 5 types of exercises to study:
 - Learn: choose answer between different options
 - Flashcards: read and guess; discover the answer by flipping the card
 - Write: type the answer to the question/definition
 - Spell: write what you hear
 - Test: 5 Written questions, 5 Matching questions, 5 Multiple choice questions, 5 True/False questions

Playing

- 3 types of exercise to play:
 - Match: Drag corresponding items onto each other to make them disappear.
 - Gravity: similar to videogame, the aim is to protect the planets from incoming asteroids by matching terms and definitions
 - Live: to play in group of minimum 4.
