Presentation

Nowadays, our smartphone is glued to our hands. We use it for everything. Communicating with friends and family, online shopping, ordering food, playing games, and so on. Should we also use smartphones for learning? Mobile learning is a new way to access learning content via mobile devices. In this course, we offer some experiences surrounding mobile or m-learning in education. The object of the seminar is the pedagogical utilization of mobile devices in the implementation of collaborative activities and their integration in education.

They will learn how to use software, platforms, and apps to communicate, manage groups and foster collaboration. They will discover how laptops, tablets and smartphones can be integrated into a teacher's toolkit.

Objectives

The purpose of this educational unit is to enrich the knowledge in matters that regard the implementation of digital mobile learning.

The trainees with the completion of their training they will have the ability:

- To define m-learning as opposed to other forms of digital learning
- To structure information, better analyse, comprehend, synthesize, recall, and generate new ideas using technological tools.
- To manage a virtual classroom, send assignments, search, and share useful materials, communicating with students and parents
- To become competent in a range of hand-held technologies
- To become innovative in the use of mobile and tablets in education
- To use Classroom management applications
- To evaluate with their mobiles
- To use motivation management tools

Pre-departure

Trainees will receive a questionnaire, which will provide information on their teaching background, qualifications, and previous experience with mobile learning and virtual classrooms, as well as their expectations of the course.

Target groups

The program is addressed to those who want to be informed about the possibilities, the advantages and the restrictions of ICT use in education. The specific targets groups are aspiring or experienced educators and teachers.

- Screen Recording (Super Recorder and Screen Recorder)
- Screen mirroring and sharing
- Screen casting (Screencast-O-Matic, OBS Studio, Icecream Screen Recorder)
- Digital Learning: apps for video making

Day 4

- Uses and functions of the Educational Apps to create interactive tasks
- Classroom management applications (Google classroom, ClassDojo, TeacherKit, Edmodo)

Day 5

- Quizzes and educational games (Kahoot, Quizizz)
- Interactive assessments with Socrative
- Motivation and classroom management tools (Decision Roulette, Lucky Cage, Pollscape, Fast Poll, Bouncy Balls)

Day 6

- Space for discussion of future cooperation and planning follow up activities
- Course roundup and final evaluation
- Validation of learning outcomes and certification ceremony
- Participants' departure
